

<a href="#">2 Corinthians 4:13</a>	It is written: "I believed; therefore I have spoken." Since we have that same spirit of faith, we also believe and therefore speak,
<a href="#">2 Corinthians 5:5</a>	Now the one who has fashioned us for this very purpose is God, who has given us the Spirit as a deposit, guaranteeing what is to come.
<a href="#">Galatians 3:2</a>	I would like to learn just one thing from you: Did you receive the Spirit by the works of the law, or by believing what you heard?
<a href="#">Galatians 3:3</a>	Are you so foolish? After beginning by means of the Spirit, are you now trying to finish by means of the flesh?
<a href="#">Galatians 3:5</a>	So again I ask, does God give you his Spirit and work miracles among you by the works of the law, or by your believing what you heard?
<a href="#">Galatians 3:14</a>	He redeemed us in order that the blessing given to Abraham might come to the Gentiles through Christ Jesus, so that by faith we might receive the promise of the Spirit.
<a href="#">Galatians 4:6</a>	Because you are his sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls out, "Abba, Father."
<a href="#">Galatians 4:29</a>	At that time the son born according to the flesh persecuted the son born by the power of the Spirit. It is the same now.
<a href="#">Galatians 5:5</a>	For through the Spirit we eagerly await by faith the righteousness for which we hope.
<a href="#">Galatians 5:16</a>	So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh.
<a href="#">Galatians 5:17</a>	For the flesh desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the flesh. They are in conflict with each other, so that you are not to do whatever you want.
<a href="#">Galatians 5:18</a>	But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.
<a href="#">Galatians 5:22</a>	But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,
<a href="#">Galatians 5:25</a>	Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.
<a href="#">Galatians 6:8</a>	Whoever sows to please their flesh, from the flesh will reap destruction; whoever sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life.
<a href="#">Ephesians 2:18</a>	For through him we both have access to the Father by one Spirit.
<a href="#">Ephesians 2:22</a>	And in him you too are being built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by his Spirit.
<a href="#">Ephesians 3:5</a>	which was not made known to people in other generations as it has now been revealed by the Spirit to God's holy apostles and prophets.
<a href="#">Ephesians 3:16</a>	I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being,
<a href="#">Ephesians 4:3</a>	Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.
<a href="#">Ephesians 4:4</a>	There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called;
<a href="#">Ephesians 5:18</a>	Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit,
<a href="#">Ephesians 6:17</a>	Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.
<a href="#">Ephesians 6:18</a>	And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people.
<a href="#">Philippians 1:19</a>	for I know that through your prayers and God's provision of the Spirit of Jesus Christ what has happened to me will turn out for my deliverance.
<a href="#">Philippians 2:1</a>	Therefore if you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any common sharing in the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion,
